The organization A Million Thanks is asking individuals, schools, churches, businesses, and other organizations to write cards, letters, and messages of appreciation for our military, past and present. It is the organization's goal to see that our military – active, reserve, and veterans – receive these messages, whether they are serving at home, abroad, or are injured in hospitals.

To participate in this service project, simply go home and write letters or make Thanksgiving cards for the military. Your letters and cards must follow these guidelines:

1. Do not put letters in individual envelopes.
2. Do not send edible items.
3. Do not use loose glitter, confetti, or anything that is not attached to the letter or card.
4. Only include positive messages. Any negative messages will be discarded.
5. Be creative! Draw pictures, talk about you, and let them know their work does not go unnoticed.
6. Include only your first name on the card or letter.

Letters and cards are due to Ms. Kendrick on A-Hall no later than MONDAY, JANUARY 17th.

If you complete this project, you may log it on your WINTER SERVICE LOG. Remember, all students who complete service in the Fall and who turn in their logs will be invited to the Fall Service Celebration. Ms. Kendrick will sign your log.
